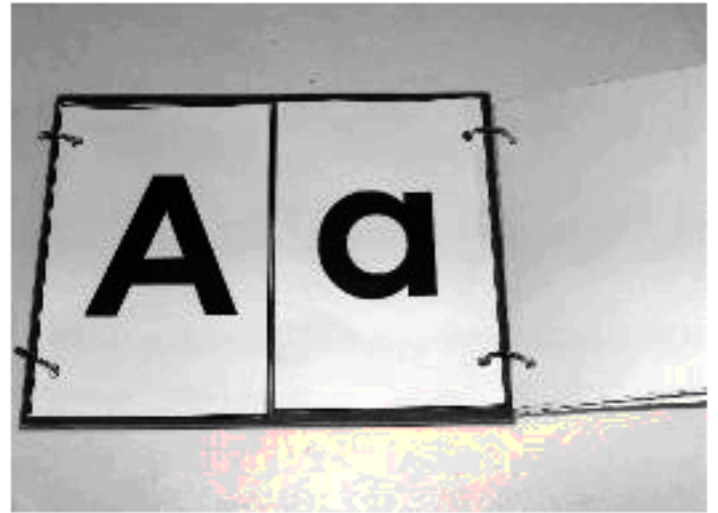
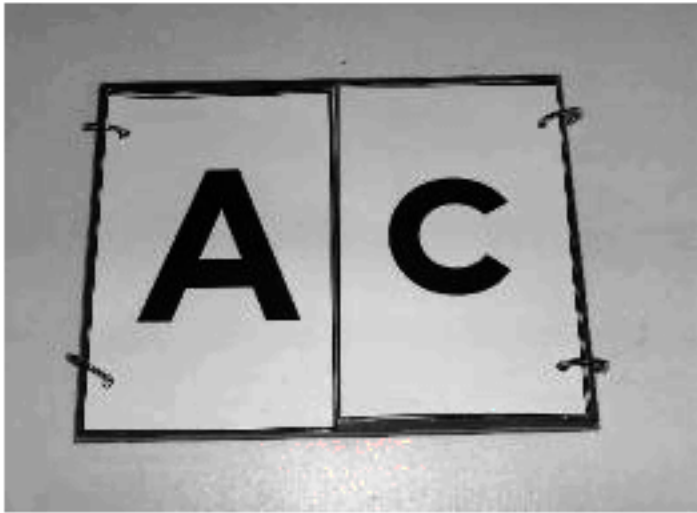


Alphabet Flip Book

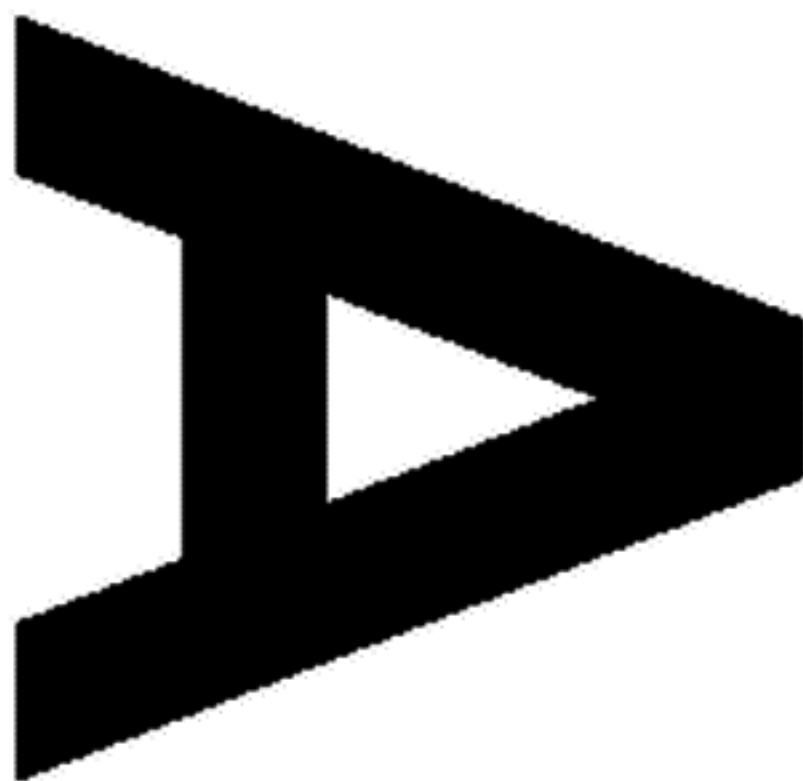
Print the alphabet pages off and punch holes in the appropriate spot.

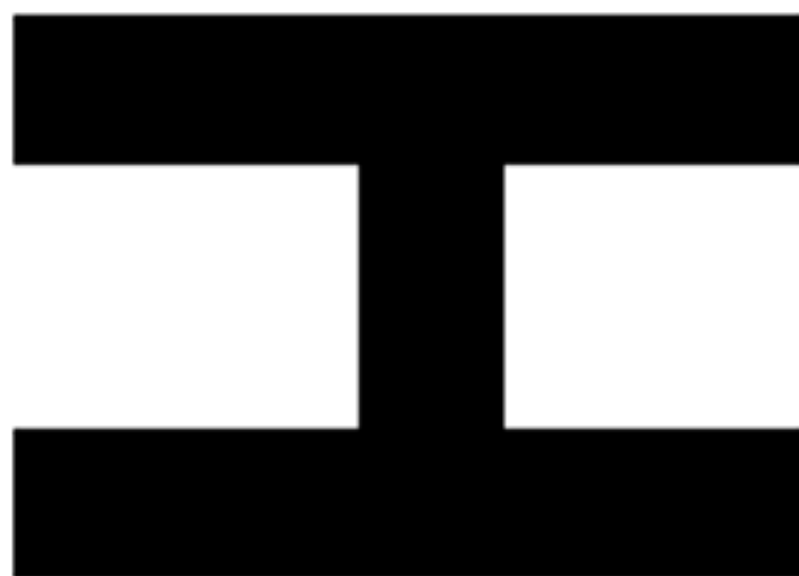

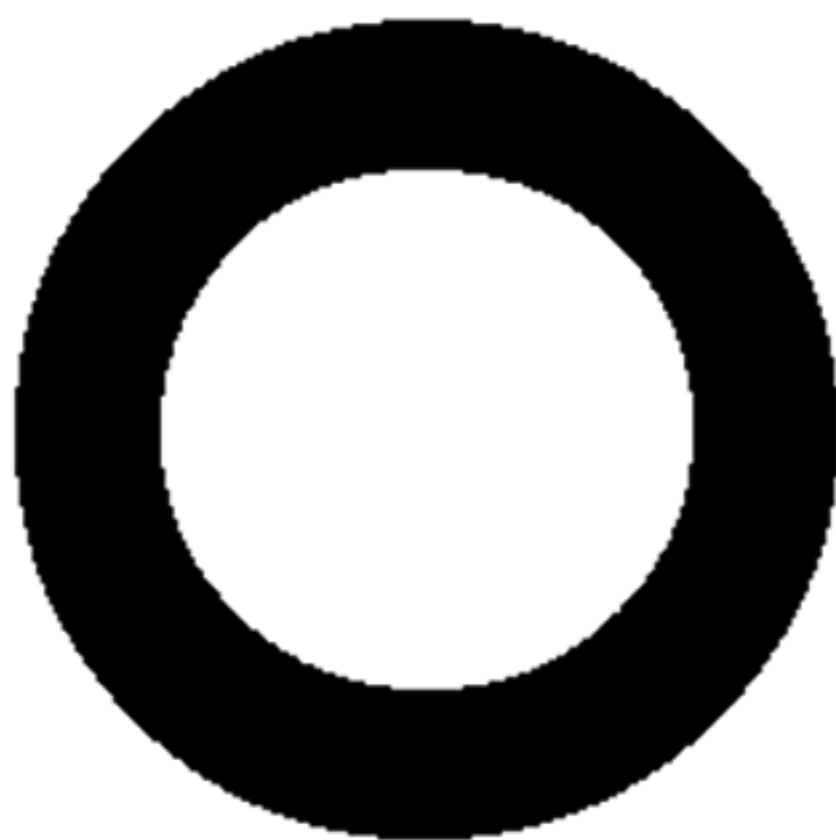

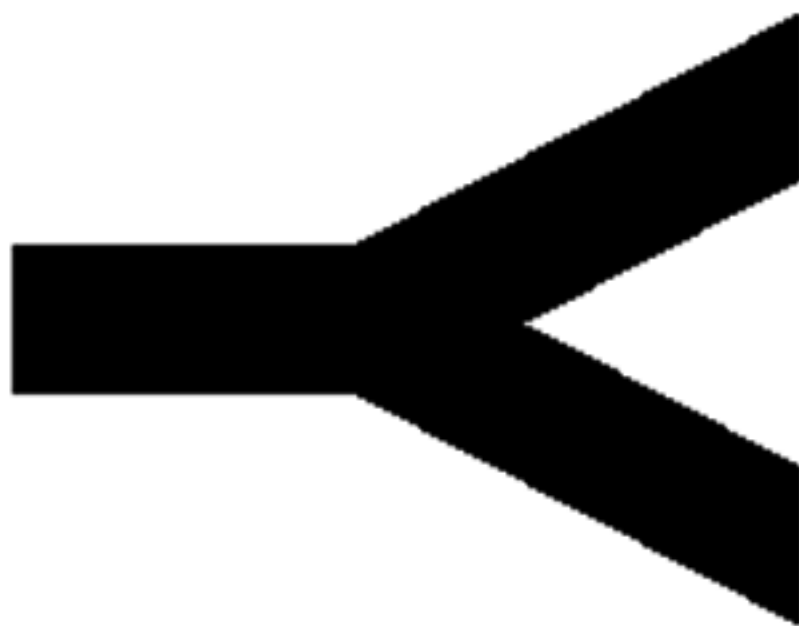
