

Number Flip Book

Create a base for your flip book. I cut a piece of thin wood to the appropriate size and drilled 4 holes into the wood. Then I placed binder rings found at the dollar store through the holes to hold the pages.

Print the number pages and punch holes in the appropriate spot.

Place the numbers on the top of the board in order. Place the pictures on the bottom of the board in random order.

Children flip the pages to match the numeral with the objects.
