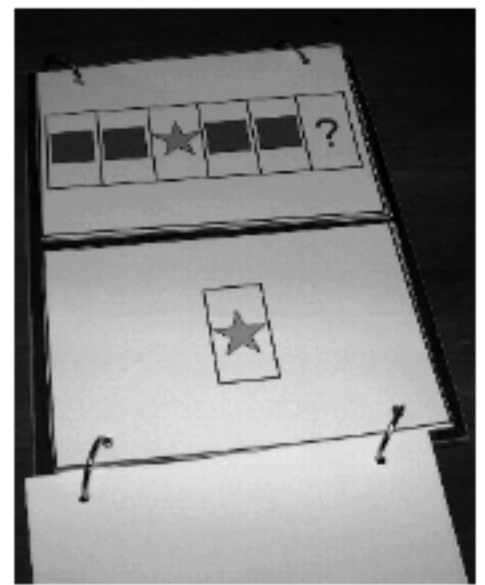
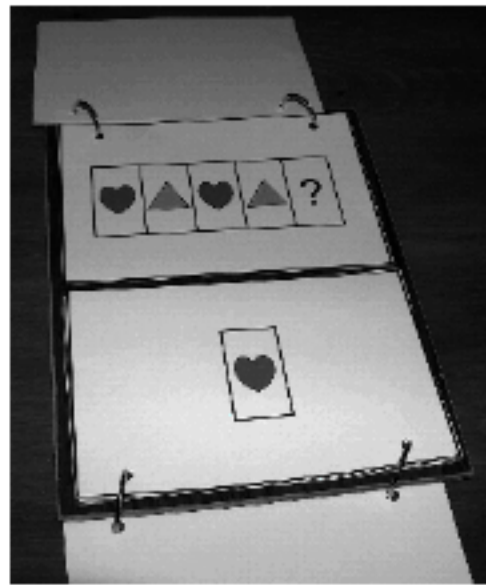
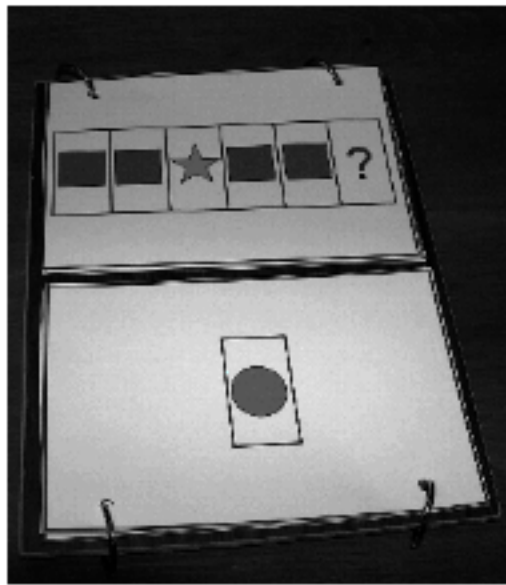


Patterning Flip Book

Print the pattern pages and punch holes in the appropriate spot.

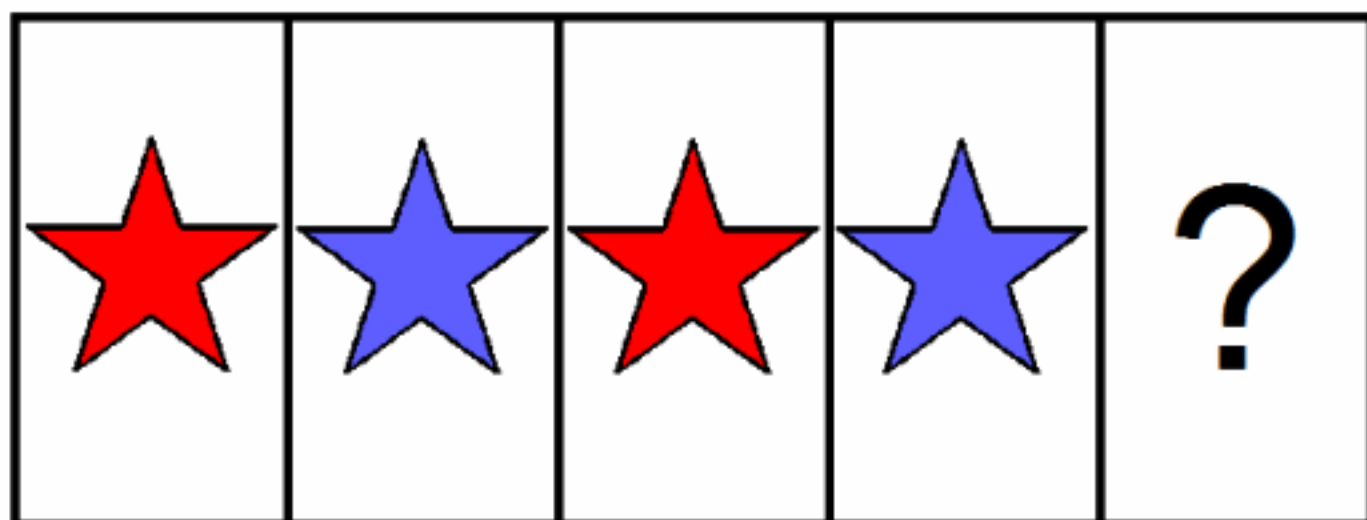
Place the patterns at the top of the board and the answer shapes at the bottom.

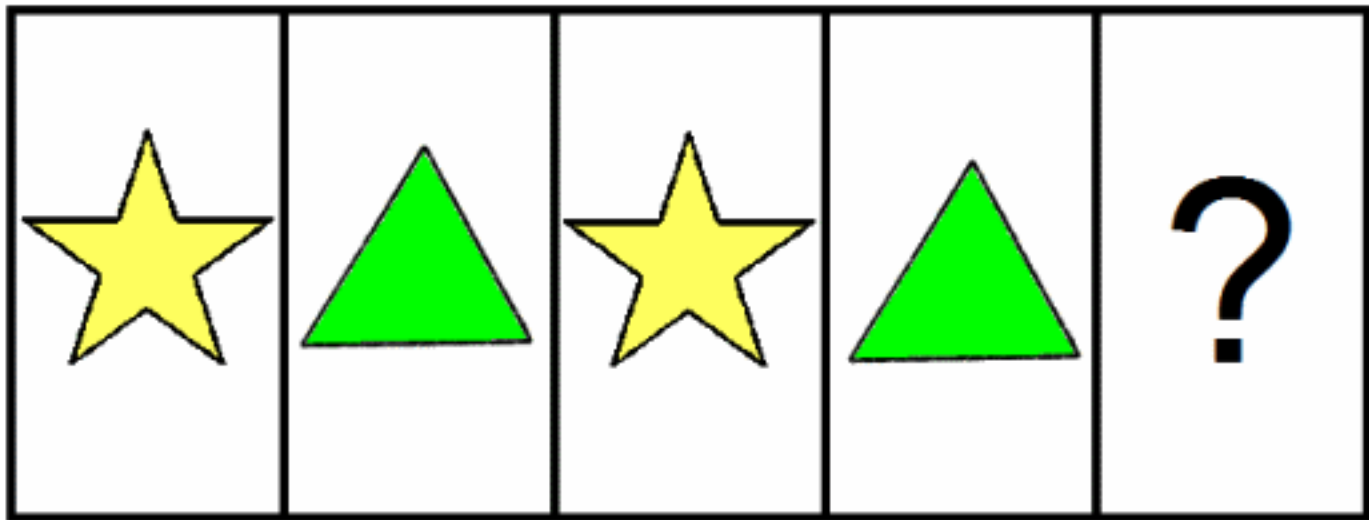
Children flip the pages to match lower and upper case letters.

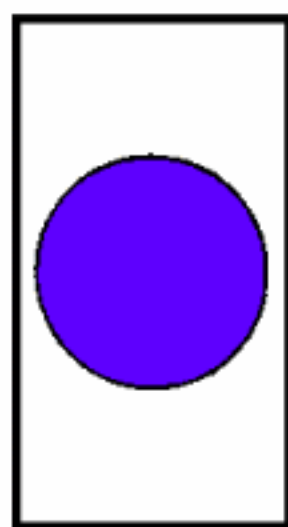
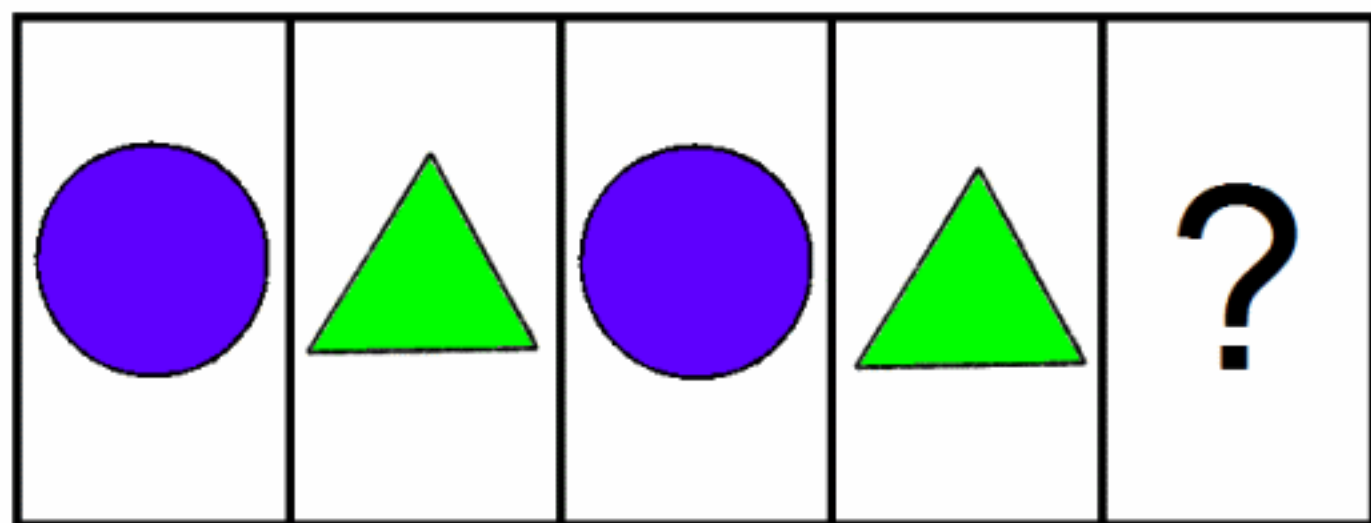
Easy and more difficult pattern cards are included to create a progressing in difficulty flip book or two separate activities.

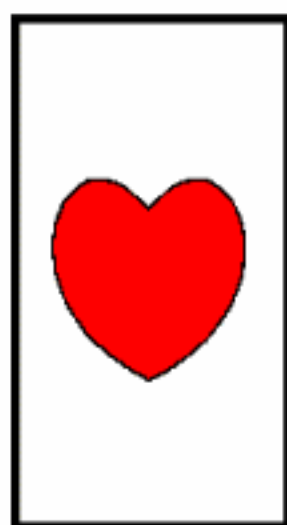
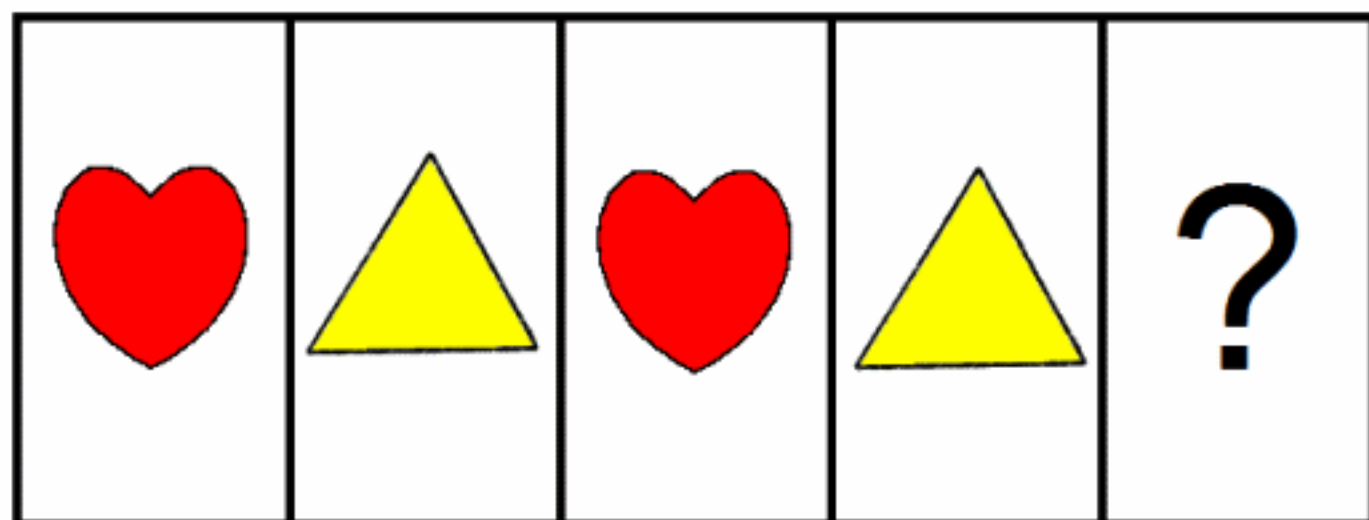
