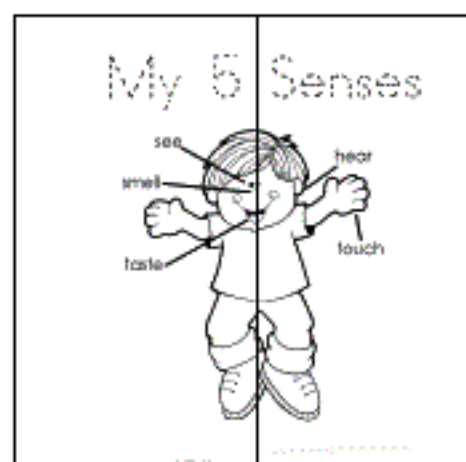


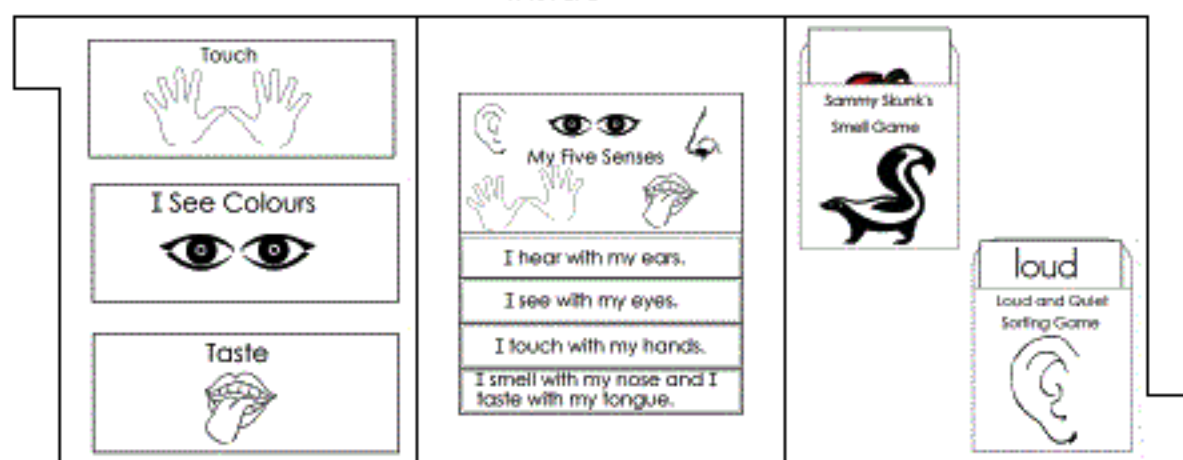
5 Senses Lapbook

Assembling Your Lapbook

Children trace the words in the touch book and glue items to each page (or pictures), assemble then add to the lapbook. I hear with my ears.

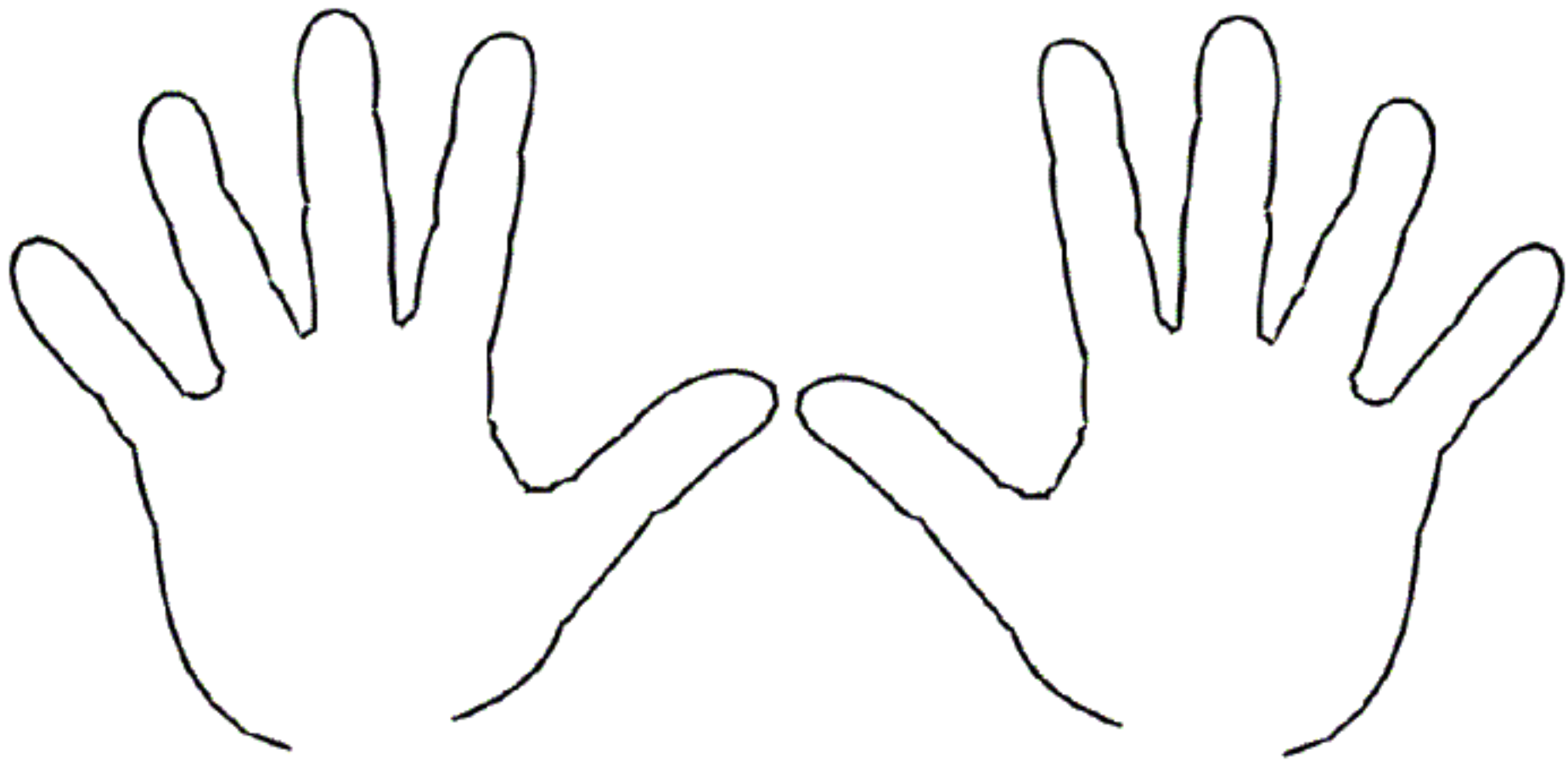
5 Senses Book - Page 3



I see with my eyes.

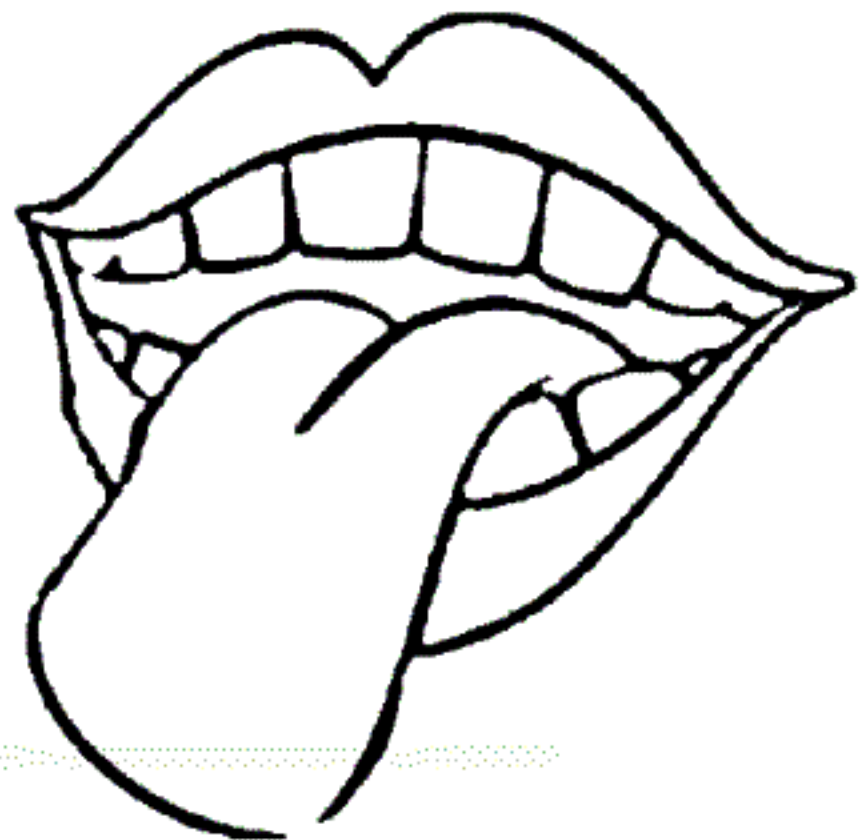
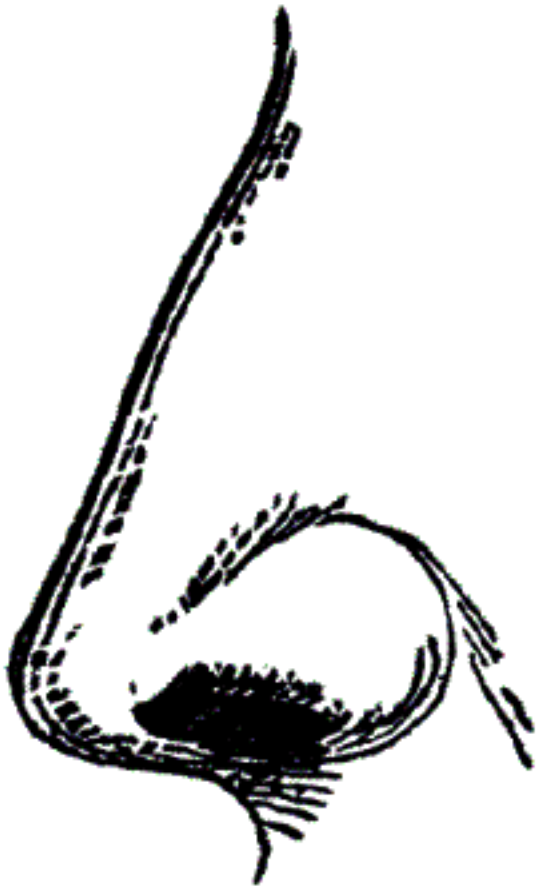
5 Senses Book - Page 4

Sammy Skunk's Smell Game



Print the envelope on card paper. Fold the back part up, fold sides in and glue closed. Glue the back to your folder. Print the smell cards on card paper and laminate. Two copies of the cards can be printed to create a matching/memory game, but not as fun as matching the actual smells!



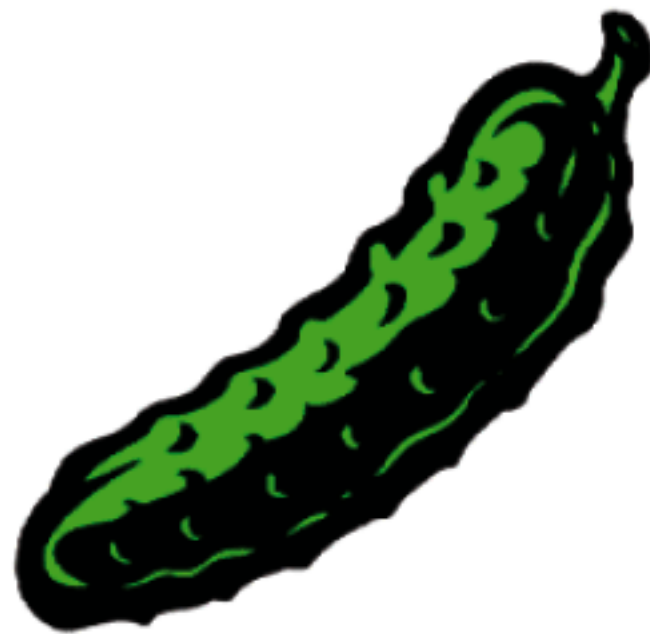

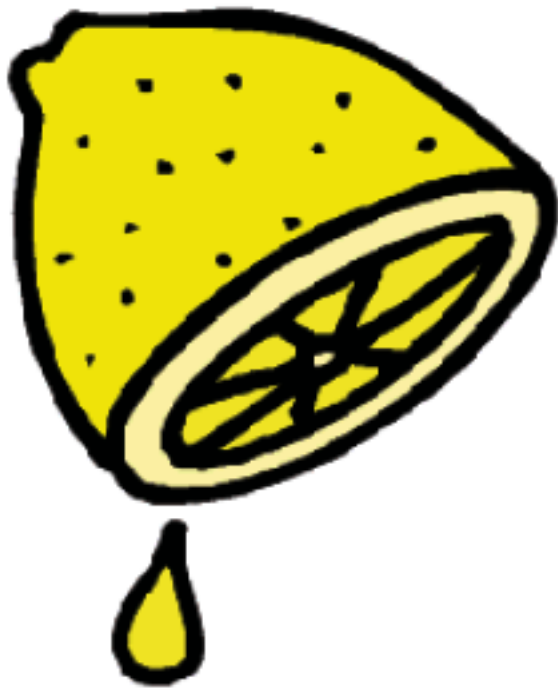

Loud and Quiet Sorting Game
