
Bean Plant Lapbook

Assembling Your Lapbook






Jack and the Beanstalk



Print the envelope on card paper. Fold the back part up and the sides in and glue closed. Glue the back of the envelope to your file folder and place the book sideways inside.





Jack and his mother were very poor. They had to sell their cow for money. Jack was told to take the cow to market.

Jack's Mom was so mad she threw the beans out the window and sent Jack to bed without supper.






In the morning, Jack saw a beanstalk had grown to the sky. He went up it and saw a large land. He met a lady who gave him some food.


He was told of a giant that lived in the house. Jack had to hide from the giant. When the giant was asleep, Jack took a bag of gold and ran home.






Jack went up the beanstalk again. This time he took a goose that laid golden eggs.


Jack went up the beanstalk again. He took a singing giant ran after Jack






Jack went down the beanstalk and called to his Mom for an axe. He chopped down the beanstalk. Jack and his Mom lived happily ever after.
