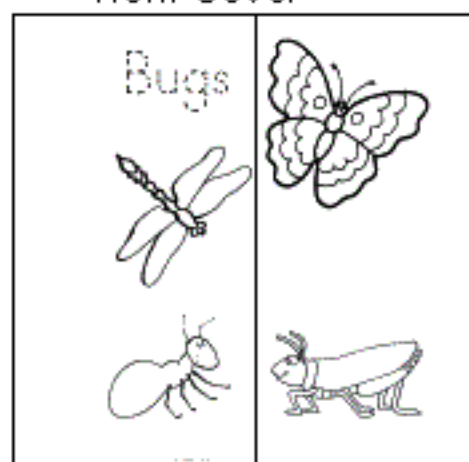


# Assembling Your Lapbook

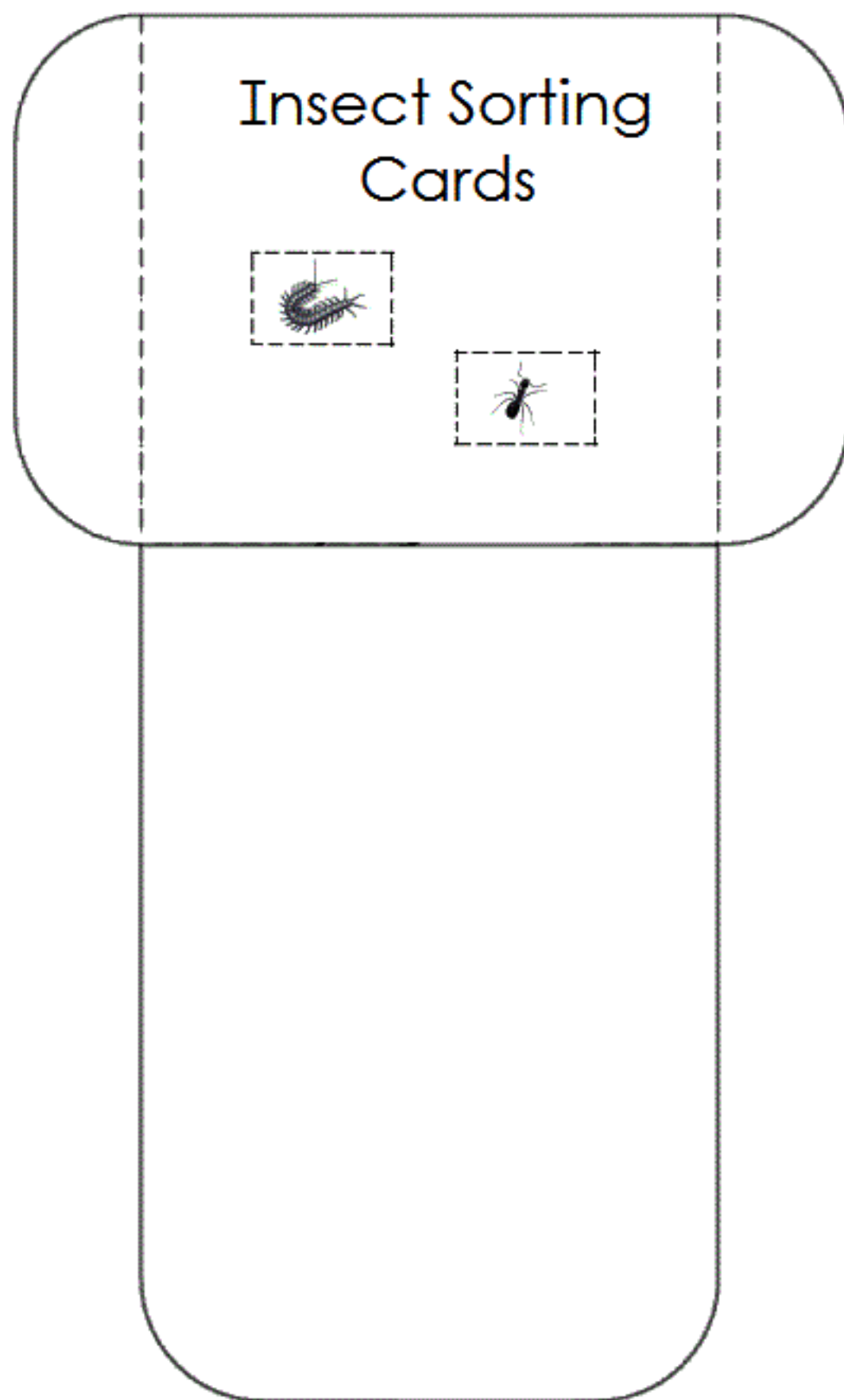
## Crawly Bug

Walk across the floor.

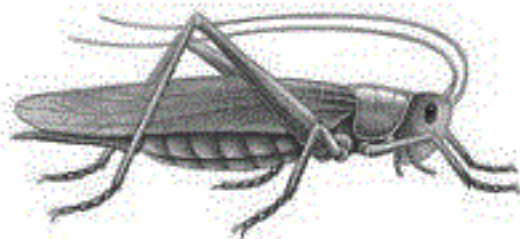
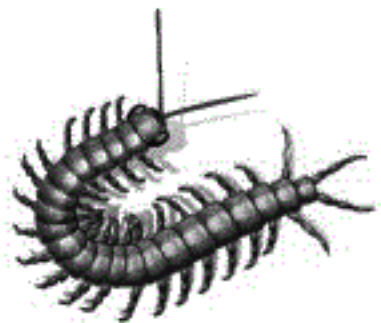
See the little crawly bug

Then down the other wall.

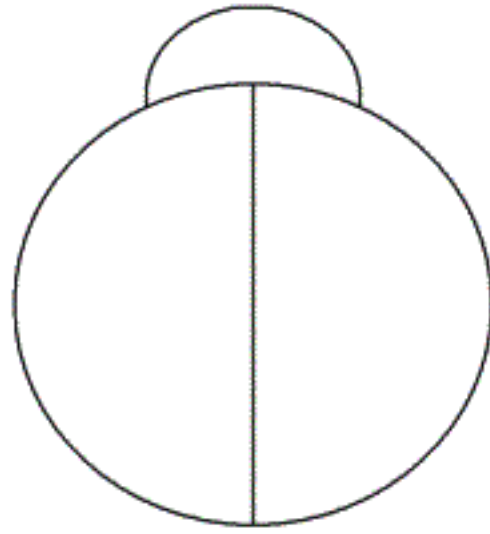
See the little crawly bug

Watching you is fun!



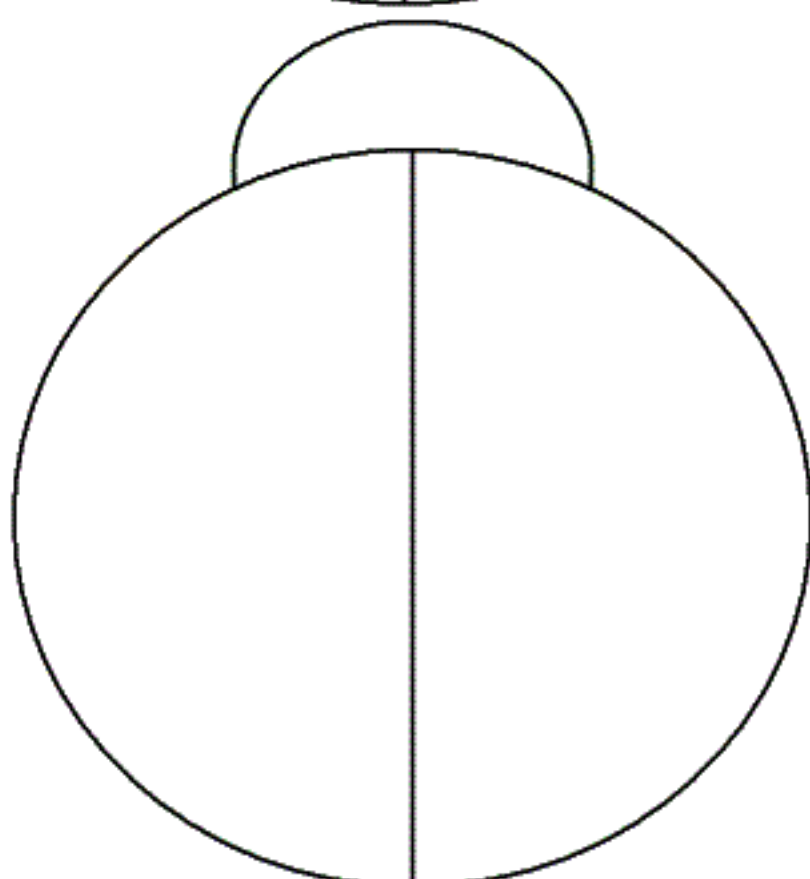
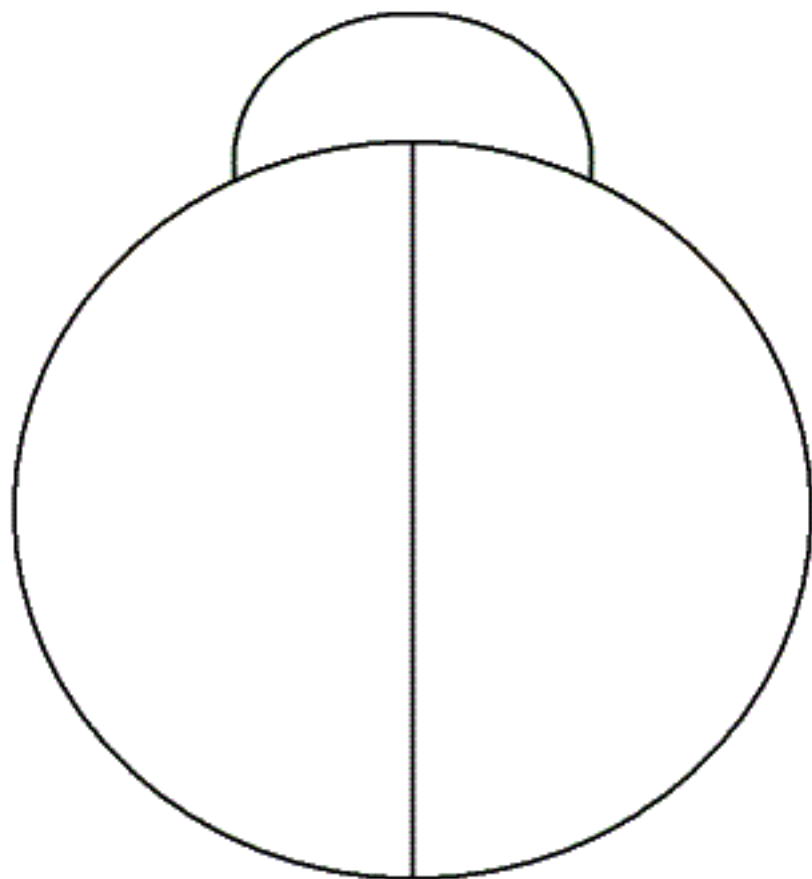
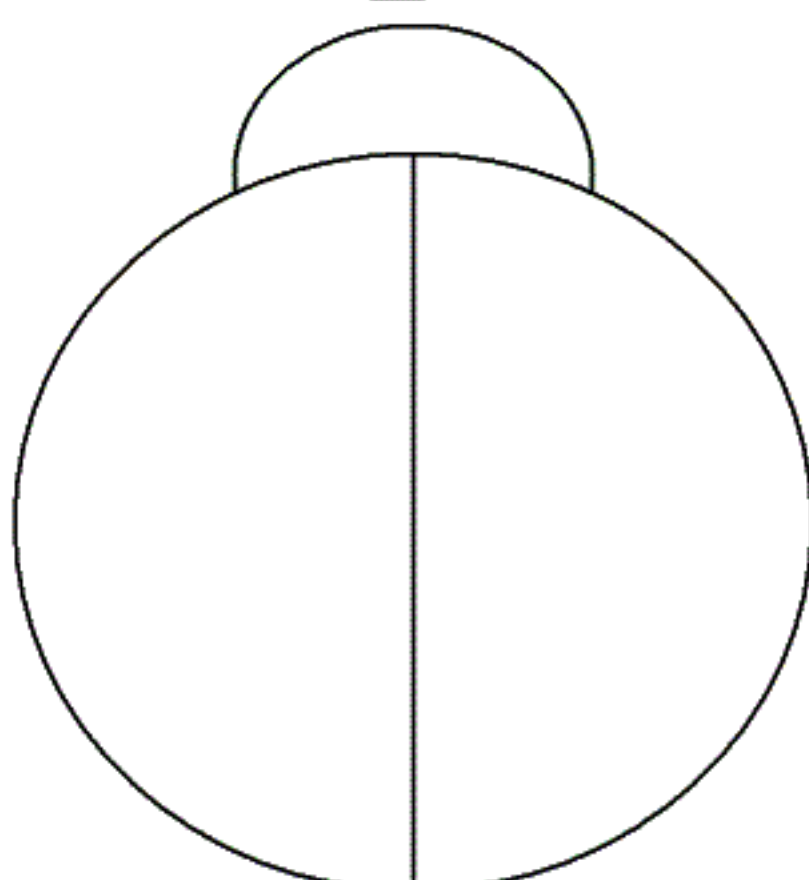
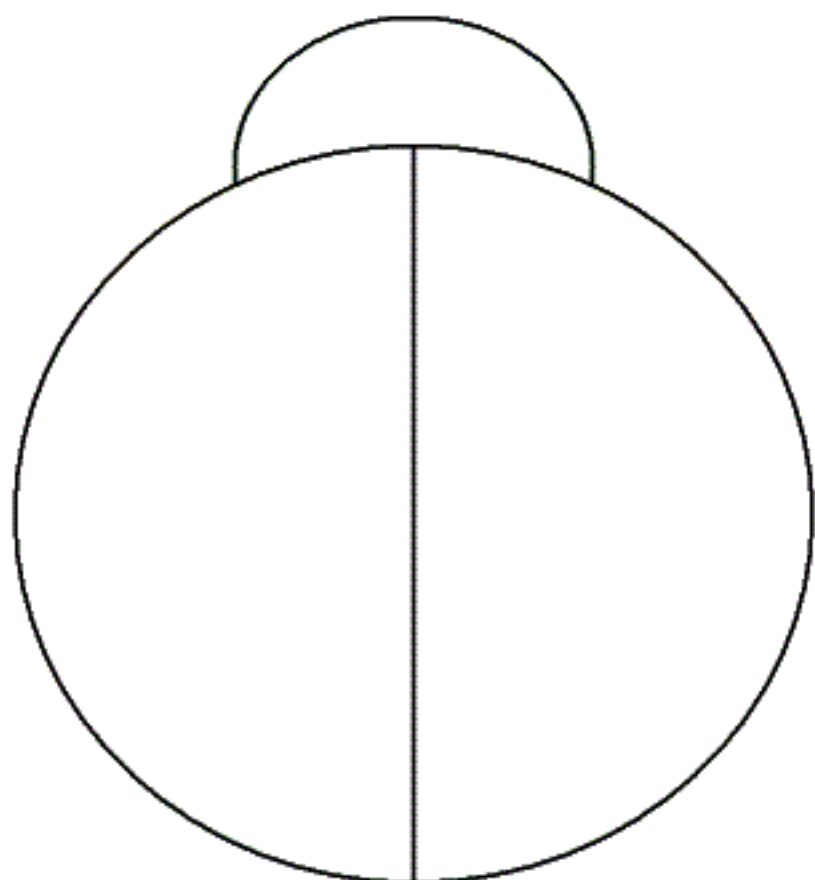
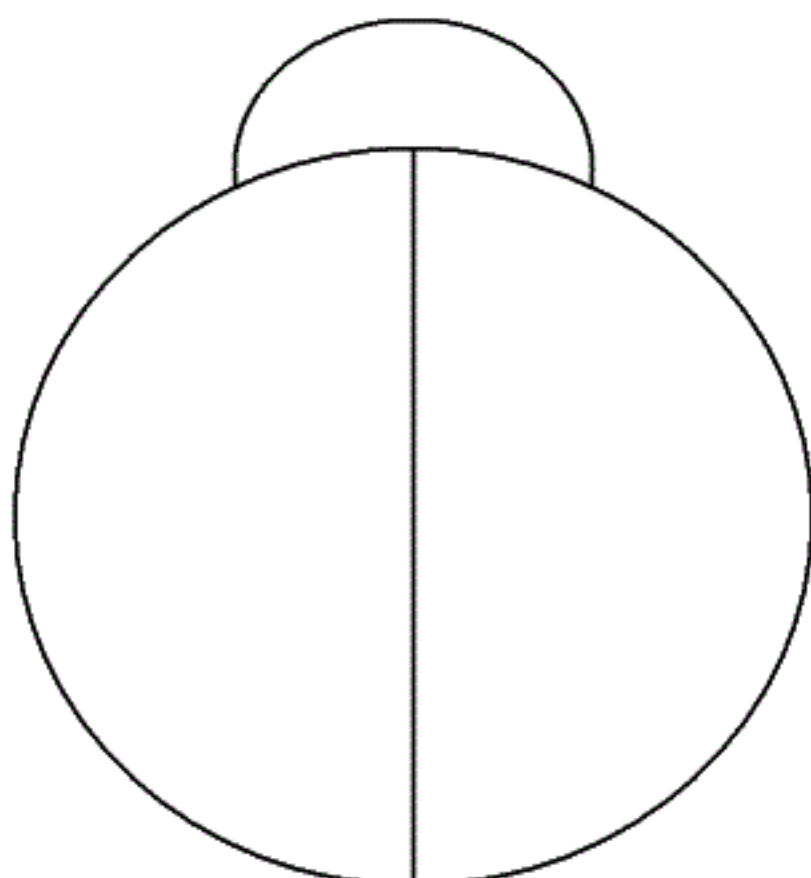
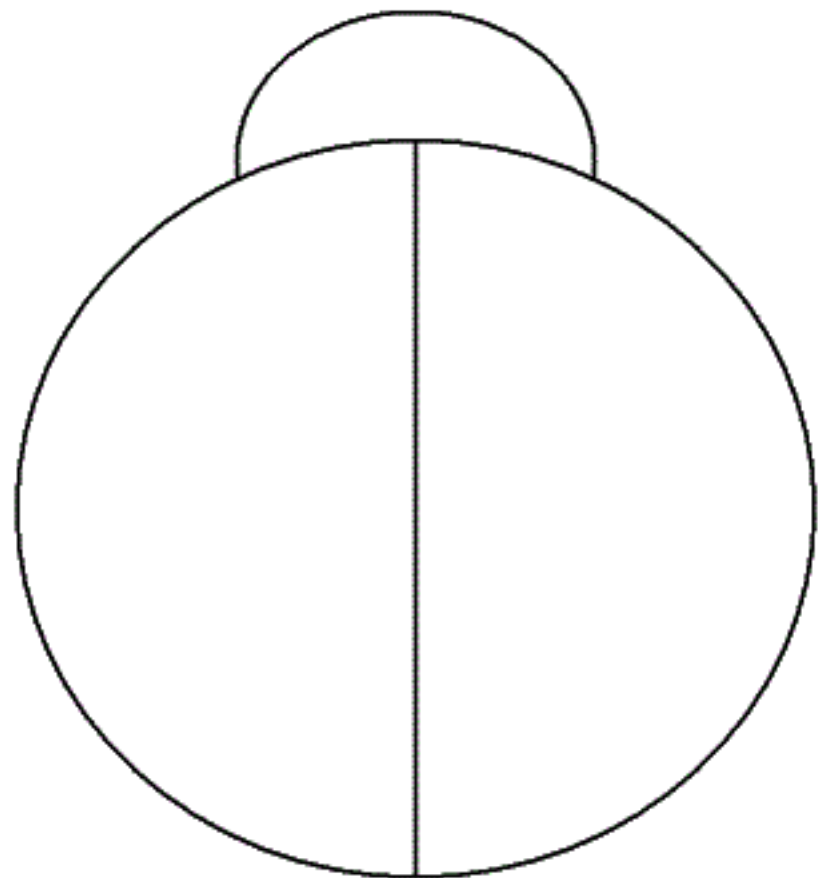
Print the envelope on card paper. Fold the back part up and the sides in and glue closed. Glue the back of your envelope to your file folder and place the insect sorting cards inside.
